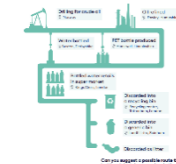
Plastic pollution

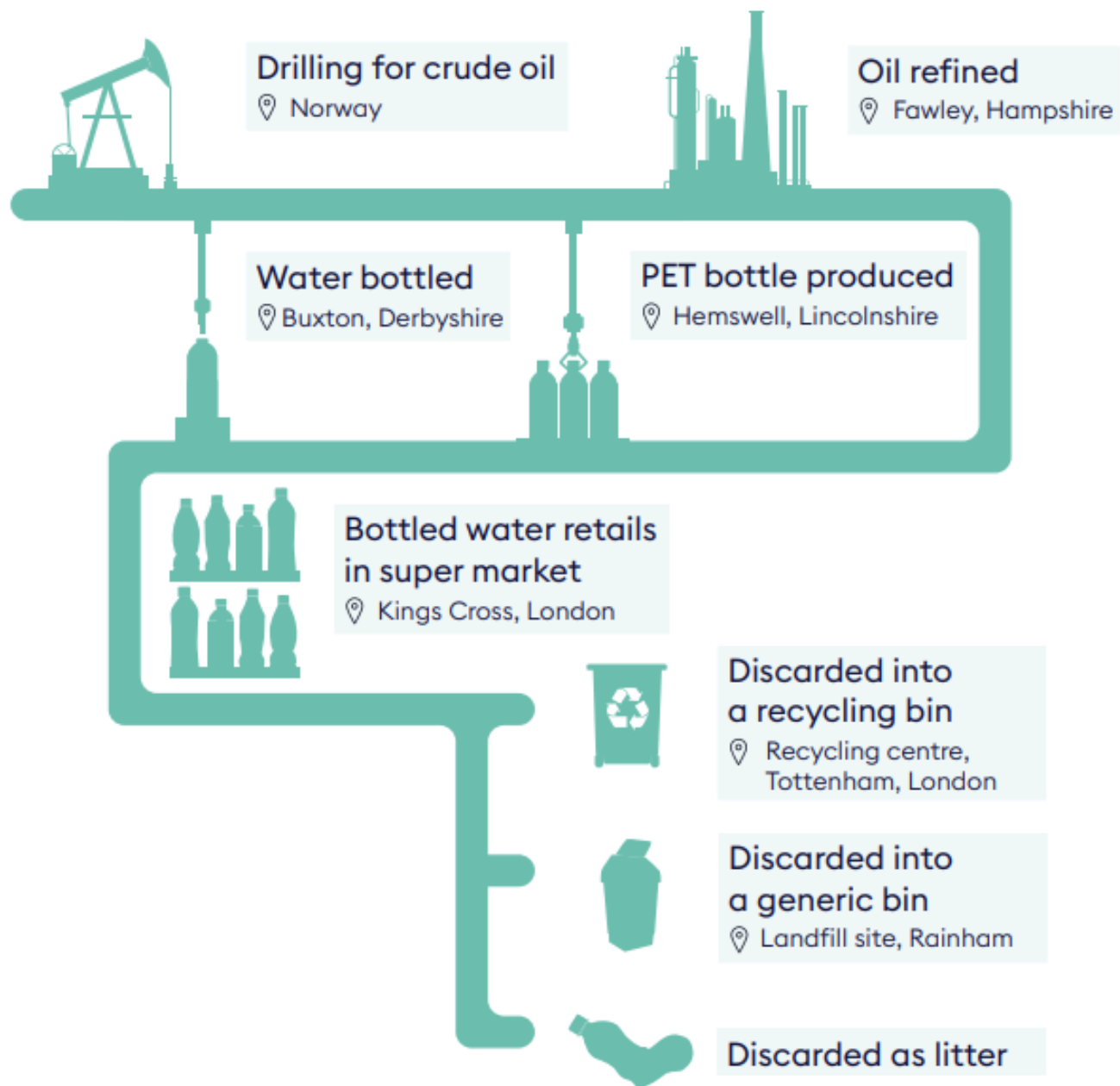
